## By the Numbers

SSD currently has approximately 140 dogs in the program. This includes those with Puppy Raisers as well as dogs in Advanced Training and breeding dogs.

$45-50 \%$ of the dogs in our program become assistance dogs
On average, each year
$20+$ dogs are placed as assistance dogs
6 dogs have a career change to K9 detection dogs

Dogs released from our program become a VIP (Very Important Pet). A Puppy Raiser may be given the opportunity to adopt the dog they raised or the dog may be adopted by someone who has applied to adopt.
